Highlight the keywords in the question before you begin. What are you being asked to do or comment on?

What is your EVIDENCE? It should support your POINT. Embed and introduce the quotation. Ensure that it is part of your sentence and it is clear what it is about. What the context of the quotation: who, when, why, where, what.	ee	
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How is your point proven in this quotation? This is where you EXPLAI what the quotation shows and ANAI how it is shown.
